



CODE OF CONDUCT – PARENT

- Do not pressure your child in any way – this is their game not yours
- Do not use bad language or harass players, coaches, officials or other spectators
- Encourage your child to play within the rules and respect officials and coaches' decisions
- Teach your child to respect the efforts of their opponents
- Children learn by example so applaud good plays and performances by both your child and their opponents
- Give positive comments and motivate and encourage continued effort
- Focus on your child's efforts and performance - not the score
- Thank the coaches, officials and other volunteers who give up their time for your child
- Help when asked by a coach or official
- Do not ridicule or criticise your child's performance after a game
- Do not arrive at any venue intoxicated or drink alcohol at Junior matches
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the game, regardless of their gender, ability or cultural background.
